- _____ Apply for admissions in Student Services or on-line at www.macc.edu/stuserv.
- _____ Be enrolled in a degree-seeking program in Student Services.
- _____ Provide an official high school transcript or GED scores to Student Services.
- _____ Provide academic transcripts from ALL previously attended institutions to Student Services.
- _____ Register for classes.



- _____ Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). MACC's Title IV School Code is 002491 and address is 101 College Avenue, Moberly, MO, 65270-1304.
- _____ Provide the verification worksheet, signed copies of federal tax forms, w-2s and/or other documentation, if requested by Financial Aid.

IF INTERESTED IN STUDENT LOANS YOU MUST:

- _____ Be enrolled in at least six (6) credit hours and maintain satisfactory academic progress.
- _____ Complete the MACC Student Loan Data Sheet and submit it to Financial Aid.
- _____ Complete, sign and date a Master Promissory Note (MPN), if you are a first-time borrower at MACC, and submit it with your Student Loan Data Sheet. You may also complete the MPN electronically using your PIN for the FAFSA at www.mohela.com/loanconnect/macc.



PLEASE NOTE: You must be making satisfactory academic progress as defined by MACC's SAP Policy; if you are currently in default on a previous student loan or owe a repayment on a Federal Grant, you are not eligible to receive any Title IV Aid (i.e. Federal Pell Grant, Stafford Loans, Work-Study, etc.) until it is resolved; you must be a U.S. Citizen or eligible non-citizen; and you must be registered with Selective Service if male, at least 18 years of age and born after December 31, 1959, and not currently a member of the active armed forces.
