

GRADUATION & TRANSFER RATES

Moberly Area Community College

The graduation and transfer rates for MACC are based on the Fall 2016 cohort of full-time, certificate- or degree-seeking students who had not previously enrolled at any MACC or any other institution of higher education. These rates reflect the percentage of students in the group who completed their respective programs of study or transferred on to a 4-year institution of higher education by August 31, 2019. The figures were compiled in compliance with the Student Right-to-Know Act, Public Law 101-542.

The graduation rate for students who entered MACC in Fall 2016 was 32%; the rate for student athletes was 47%. The transfer rate to 4-year institutions for students (non-graduates) who entered MACC in Fall 2016 was 17%. The transfer rate to 4-year institutions for student athletes (non-graduates) entering at the same time was 29%.
