On **Tuesday, January 30, 2024 at 9:30**, MACC will be visiting Kirksville High School to enroll students for dual credit classes. **HOWEVER, you are REQUIRED to turn in the YELLOW MACC Enrollment Form to KHS Counseling Office No LATER than Wednesday, January 24, 2024.** Dual credit classes cost \$80 per credit hour. Most courses are worth three credit hours each and cost \$240 per course. If you take a course that is worth more than 3 hours, plan to adjust your payment accordingly. MACC now processes payment for courses electronically, through an online process.
