Bid Due: Sealed bids must be received 4/20/26 at 10am. Late bids will not be accepted.

Bidders are strongly encouraged to visit the site prior to submitting a bid. Submission of a bid shall be considered acknowledgment that the bidder has examined existing conditions and included all costs necessary to complete the work described.

Project Overview

Moberly Area Community College is seeking bids from qualified contractors to restore an existing detention basin to its original functional condition while improving long-term erosion resistance. The project includes grading, erosion repair, reinforced materials, concrete repairs, and site restoration.

Scope of Work

The contractor shall provide all labor, materials, equipment, tools, supervision, and incidentals required to complete the following work:

- Remove and dispose of existing rock and landscape edging within the detention basin.
- Reinstall the flared end section disconnected from the north storm pipe outlet and ensure proper alignment and stabilization.

- Regrade the bottom of the detention basin to original plan grade to restore proper drainage.
- Supply and install approved separation geotextile fabric on prepared soil subgrade.
- Supply and install white limestone riprap over fabric. Riprap shall be larger and more durable than existing material and suitable for stormwater flow conditions.
- Form and pour flowable fill concrete beneath the south spillway to repair erosion under the existing concrete slab.
- Backfill and compact fill material along the east side of the spillway.
- Form and pour approximately 10 linear feet of concrete curb on top of the east side of the spillway slab to improve erosion control.
- Add topsoil to the west slope to repair lawn mower rutting and fine grade for turf.
- Seed, straw, and fertilize all disturbed areas affected by construction activities.

Materials and Workmanship

All materials shall be new and suitable for long-term erosion control applications. Workmanship shall result in stable, durable installations capable of withstanding normal and heavy stormwater flows.

Alternate No. 1: Remove and dispose of two (2) existing trees located at the top of the west slope, including stump removal and surface restoration.

Contractor Responsibilities

- Provide all equipment, including excavation and safety measures such as utility locates.
- Maintain safe work zones and protect adjacent roadways and campus property.
- Restore all areas not specifically designated as part of the final construction.

Exclusions

- Any work not explicitly described in this bid package.
- Permits, bonds, overtime labor, and shift work unless otherwise noted.
