Dual credit classes are a great way to receive college credit while still in high school. These courses will be taught in your high school by instructors who have been approved by MACC. These instructors have a Master's degree and will be teaching the course according to college standards. Academic dual credit classes will transfer to most public and private institutions in the state. On **Tuesday, September 21, 2021 at 1:30 p.m.**, MACC will be visiting Clark County R-I High School to enroll students for dual credit classes. Dual credit classes cost **\$78 per credit hour**. **The student is responsible for the textbooks for the online classes.** Your classes must be paid in full on the day of enrollment or have a payment plan through MACC. Divide the total amount due by three. **The first payment is due on 9/21/2021** the day of enrollment. Following payments are due on **10/21/2021 and 11/15/2021**.
