Dual credit classes are a great way to receive college credit while still in high school. These courses are taught in your high school by instructors who have been approved by MACC. These instructors have a Master's degree and will be teaching the course according to college standards. Academic dual credit classes will transfer to most public and private institutions in the state. On **Wednesday, September 8th, 2021 at 9:00 a.m.**, MACC will be visiting Moberly Senior High School. Dual credit classes cost **\$45 for IN-DISTRICT** per credit hour and **\$78 per credit hour for OUT OF DISTRICT**. For the Online classes, the students are responsible for the textbook. Your classes must be paid in full on the day of enrollment. Payment plans are available through MACC. Divide the total amount due by three. **The first payment** is due on **9/8/2021**, the day of enrollment. Following payments are due **10/8/2021 and 11/8/2021**. Students may pay via VISA, MasterCard, Discover, Check, Money Order, or cash.
