Dual credit classes are a great way to receive college credit while still in high school. These courses will be taught in your high school by instructors who have been approved by MACC. These instructors have a Master's degree and will be teaching the course according to college standards. Academic dual credit classes will transfer to most public and private institutions in the state. On **Friday, September 24th, 2021 at 10:15 a.m.**, MACC will be visiting Monroe City R-I High School to enroll students for dual credit classes. Dual credit classes cost \$78 per credit hour. Most courses are worth three credit hours each and cost \$234 per course. The student is responsible for the cost of the book for ONLINE classes. Your classes must be paid in full on the day of enrollment or have a payment plan in place. Payment plans are available through MACC. Divide the total amount by three. **The first payment** is due on **9/24/2021**, the day of enrollment. Following payments are due on **10/15/2021** and the final payment is due on **10/30/2021**.
